

Plug in, Play!

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Welcome to Plug in, Play!

Each piece is designed to be played with the backing tracks on the accompanying CD. For each piece there are two versions on the CD: one with the melody to help you learn the tune, and then one without the melody so you become the lead! There is a two-bar click-in on each track, apart from those that start with a bars rest for the performer. Simply count '1...2...1,2,3,4' and then you're in.

So, plug in your headphones and get playing!
